Agenda No. 4	Safety Camera System Update (DMi)
	• There are currently seven cameras throughout the Santa Maria campus. Cameras are located at the ballfields facing the vineyard, parking lot #7 on the emergency phone, building G, the ARC, inside and outside of building F, and building M. The cameras inside of building F are in public spaces only.
	PD and ITS will discuss locations for additional cameras and intend to purchase more.
	• LVC has a stand-alone system. Though it is functioning, it will be evaluated at a later date for upgrade. There are a few throughout the campus with one at the library.
	• These are not monitored 24/7. They are not designed to do so. They are used for "in-the-moment" viewing and assists in perpetrator identifications.
Agenda No. 5	Safety Incentive Program Funding Request, April 17 (KC)
Discussion:	SM – Reimbursements will be requested, in particularly for Stop-the-Bleed kits. Funds were awarded to replace back-pack blowers for wheeled blowers. This improves efficiency and reduces strain on staff.
Agenda No. 6	SB County Public Health Opioid Settlement Grant (DMi/AD)
Discussion:	• DMi – This was tentatively approved with required revisions. Still waiting for confirmed approval. Over the next couple of years, this will provide counseling sessions, town-halls, and promotional items.
Agenda No. 7	Emergency Operations Center (EOC) Tabletop Training, April 4 (DMi)
Discussion:	• Last tabletop moved to semi-virtual to have teams fill out forms online. Plans for future trainings will revisit previous topics and upping the scenario in a virtual format where EOC main members will be in-person and others in the field remotely filling out forms through Teams.
